

# **Financial Aid Available to International Students at the National Taiwan University of Science and Technology**

## **A. Eligibility:**

### **a. Undergraduate**

1. A full-time undergraduate international student, who has completed his/her previous semester (carrying no less than 6 credits) with a GPA higher than 3.0 and has received no demerit for his/her behavior, is eligible to apply for this financial aid. He/she may apply a maximum of four times.

2. Required documents:

- An application form.
- An official transcript of the previous semester.

### **b. Graduate**

1. A full-time graduate international student, who has completed his/her previous semester (carrying no less than 4 credits) with a GPA higher than 3.38 and has received no demerit for his/her behavior, is eligible to apply for this financial aid. While enrolled in a graduate degree program, a master's degree student may apply for this financial aid only one time; a Ph.D. degree student may apply only twice.

2. Required documents:

- An application form.
- An official transcript of the previous semester.
- A letter of recommendation from thesis advisor.
- A proposal for thesis, including the following sections: the purpose and motivation of the study, the structure and design of the study, the sources of and methods for collecting data, an outline of the thesis, and references.

- c. Those who have already been granted other forms of financial aid from the Taiwan government or from this university may not apply for this financial aid.
- B. The source of this financial aid is the National Taiwan University of Science and Technology.
- C. The financial aid does not cover the tuition and no monthly stipends. The application document will be evaluated by the scholarship committee. Once you are awarded financial aid, you will receive stipend payment of financial aid one time only, and the amount given per student will depend on the amount of funding provided by the National Taiwan University of Science and Technology and the number of applicants.
- D. Time to file an application:  
To be announced once every semester. For detailed information, please refer to the relevant university announcements.
- E. Issued process:  
The scholarship payment will be deposited into recipient's account after the final result has been approved by the university.
- F. These regulations and any revisions will go into effect upon approval by the Administrative Council and the President of the university.
