

Saxon Student Mobility Program Extension of funding for 2026/27

- Information for students from Taiwan -

Who is eligible for funding?

Students from Taiwanese universities, who plan to study or participate in a research stay at a Saxon university (without obtaining a degree).

Application requirements:

- good to very good academic performances
- English language skill of at least B2
- enrollment at a Taiwanese university
- applicants must be enrolled at a host university in Saxony and at their home university for the entire duration of their stay abroad

What can be funded?

1. Long-term stay (1 – 6 months)

- a. Participation in classes (seminars, lectures, etc.)
- b. Completion of research, study or project work and/or participation in a research project at a host university (academic supervision by a university lecturer from the relevant department at the host university, applicants must establish contact independently)

2. Short-term stays (5 days – 30 days)

- a. Summer Schools / Winter Schools
- b. Language courses
- c. Study trips

How much funding is available?

For a long-term stay:

850 €/month (calculated on a daily basis)

For a short-term stay:

Tag 1 – 14: 79 €/day

Tag 15 – 30: 56 €/day

one-time travel allowance:

2.125 € for Taiwan

Social Top-Up (if applicable):

250 €/month (calculated on a daily basis)

Applications are open for first-time university students¹, students with child(ren), students with disabilities or chronic illnesses, and working students.

Additional costs relation to the study or research exchange

(not covered by the Saxon Student Mobility Program):

- costs for travel (arrival, departure, etc.) that exceed the travel allowance

¹ applies to students who are the first in their family to pursue a university degree and whose parents do not have a university degree

- accommodation in a student hall or flat share (depending on the accommodation approx.. 160 – 400 €/month)
- valid health insurance (approx.. 100 €/month, must be taken out after arrival in Saxon for the duration of the study or research exchange. Please note that travel insurance from the home country will not be recognized)
- semester fee (approx. 270 – 300 €, depending on the host university, semester ticket for public transport in Germany included)
- course fees for summer/winter schools, language courses, etc.

Application

Application periods and deadlines:

15.01. – 15.03. for applications for the following winter semester

15.07. – 15.09. for applications for the following summer semester

Application documents

- **Learning Agreement** (for semester-based stays; attendance of classes): classes for ca. 20 – 25 ECTS credits, or at least 4 study-related classes; signed by the student, home and host university
- **Project description** (for non-semester based research stays): brief description of the research project, max. 1 page; signature by supervisors at home and host university
- **Transcript** of current grades; Bachelor's or Master's degree certificates, if available
- **Letter of motivation:** description and justification of the study project at the host university, ca. 1 – 2 pages
- **CV**
- **Letter of Reference** from a university lecturer with a doctorate in a subject related to the exchange
- **Language certificate** (not older than 2 years):
 - for participation in German-language classes: proof of at least B1
 - for participation in English-language classes: proof of at least B2
- **Certificate of Enrollment** from home university
- **Letter of Acceptance** from host university
- **valid visa** for the planned stay (can be submitted later)

The application documents will be checked for completeness after the application period has ended. Applicants will receive **feedback on the completeness status of their application within two weeks**. Missing or incorrect documents can be submitted during this period upon request.

Notification about acceptance or rejection of the application will be send **within two months** after the end of the application period.
