Health Examination for New Students

- Time: to be announced by OIA in the beginning of each semester
- Location: 2nd floor of the Gymnasium
- Fee: About 550NTD (cash)

Notes:

- Please come on time with one passport sized photo.
- Please have enough rest and drink enough water three days before the health test. On the day of the health check, please do not take any food and water 1 hour prior to the examination.
- On the day of the health check, please do not wear clothes with metal and shiny beads. Please do not wear any makeup, and don not bring valuable possessions.
- If you are pregnant or if you suspect a pregnancy, please let us know. You should not take X-ray scans.

Typical symptoms of dengue fever Headache Pain behind the eyes Fever up to 38 degrees Rash Bone, joint or muscle pain

How to prevent infection:

- Empty containers and ornamental fountains or cover them with covers.
- Clean vases and ornamental fountains weekly.
- Flatten canvas covers and fill up holes on the ground.
