Visa

All international exchange students are strongly advised to apply for a visitor/resident visa, depending on the following circumstances.

- **Visitor's visa (exchange for 1 semester):** For those who will stay in Taiwan for less than 6 months, extension available in Taiwan. [Info Here](#)

- **Resident Visas (exchange for 2 semesters):** For those who will study in Taiwan for more than 6 months, [Info Here](#).
PS. Those who arrive in Taiwan with a Resident Visa must apply for an **Alien Resident Certificate (ARC)** within 30 days from the arrival date. [ARC application information](#)

- **Mandarin Class:** Mandarin Chinese courses at NTUST **CANNOT** be added online directly. Students have to go to the class they want to add during the first week and take a placement test. If they are suitable for the course, they will get the authorization code to add the course manually on the system.

- These two courses--Oral Training in Basic Chinese and Mandarin Chinese Practical (Level 1)--are for true beginners, and no placement test is required, but students **still have to attend** the first class to get the authorization code from the instructor.

The guide from the Taoyuan Airport to Taipei:

◆ **By MRT (Service time 06:00-24:00):**

Step 1. Take the Taoyuan Airport MRT express train to Taipei Main Station

- ◆ **By Taxi:** Fastest and most comfortable after a couple of hours' flight. It costs around TWD\$ 1300-1800, depending on your destination. There is a Taxi Spot when arriving at the airport.

How to get to Taiwan Tech Campus:

- **MRT:** Gongguan Station (Green line G07) and a 10-minute walk.

- **Bus:** #1, #207, #275, #275(Sub), #275(Shuttle), #650, #672, #673, #907, #11(Green Line), #12 (Brown Line), Dunhua Main Line

Accommodation

◆ **On-campus housing:**

Due to high demand and limited facilities, accommodation in on-campus dormitories can only be offered to full-time degree students.

◆ **Off-campus housing:**

- **Private Rental:** Taipei offers a wide range of accommodations. Reasonable rates per person per month lie between NT\$ 7500- NT\$ 15000 (Around USD 250-500 Per Month), depending on room types and location.

Recommended areas: Da'an District and Zhongzheng District where Taiwan Tech, National Taiwan Normal University, and National Taiwan University are located. Many Taiwan Tech students live in Yonghe district in New Taipei City where rents are cheaper than in the city center.

Living Cost

- ◆ Accommodation Fee:
 - Off-Campus Private Rental: Around USD 250-500 per Month
- ◆ Meal Expense: Around USD 200-300 per Month
- ◆ Transportation fee: Around USD 50 per Month
- ◆ Phone/ Internet Bill: Around USD 20-30 per Month
