Courses

- The language of instruction at Taiwan Tech is mainly Chinese; however, the university offers more than 160 courses in English each semester at Graduate Level, and more English-taught courses are developing at the Undergraduate level.

- Course selection information will be announced by the Academic Affairs Office. Course lists are usually announced 1-2 months before the semester starts.

Minimum Credits or course selection regulation per semester

<u>Bachelor</u>: 9 credits. Students in the last year of bachelor's level are allowed to take courses at the Master's level.

Master: 1 course. Students could take courses in different departments.

Ph.D.: 1 course. Students could take courses in different departments.

Note: 1 credit = 16 teaching hours, 1 course = 2 or 3 credits.

Each course lasts a semester (16 weeks). 1 credit is equal to 2 ECTS credits.

Free Mandarin Chinese Program

The Chinese Language Program (CLP) at Taiwan Tech is designed especially for international students and other Chinese learners. This program focuses on daily conversation on various topics, such as eating, clothing, living, transportation, and entertainment. The CLP is offered by the Language Center and a placement test will be conducted at the beginning of the semester.

Accommodation

Taiwan Tech is not able to provide on-campus. However, we have a list of housing agents/contacts, and will forward the information to students who need flats during their stay at Taiwan Tech.

Exchange Student Application Procedure

- (1) Students who wish to join our exchange program should be nominated from their home university. Please inform us of the quota you'd like to nominate. Nomination time is by <u>April 15</u> and <u>Oct 15</u>.
- (2) Partner universities will receive a nomination link with access to the nomination system. Please submit the nominee's information and students will receive a link for the application. All application documents are to be uploaded to the platform. Hard copies are not required for application.
- (3) Once accepted students and coordinators could download the Letter of Acceptance online.

- Starting from the batch of the Spring 2026 semester (application period: September October 2025), students should submit the language certificate during the application procedure.

Health Certification (after being accepted by NTUST)

According to the government's regulations, all short-term students should submit health certification. The certification should include the examinations below:

- 1. A MMR vaccination proof.
- 2. A chest X-ray examination for tuberculosis check.
